### Supra Invoicing Switch Delayed

The switch over from our current Supra Lockboxes to the new Supra Invoicing Lockboxes has been delayed. The delay is due to the tariffs that have been placed on multiple countries, as a result parts needed for the Supra Invoicing have experienced significant delays.

We will keep you updated as we hear from Supra on anticipated timelines for the switch over.



### Open House Signage

We ask that members remember the importance of complying with all applicable municipal bylaws when conducting open houses or placing signage. Bylaw requirements can vary significantly between municipalities, and it is the responsibility of the member to review and follow the regulations specific to the municipality in which the property is located.

For example, some municipalities such as the City of Red Deer, have specific bylaws governing how long open house signage may be displayed, which is no sooner than 3 hours before and no later than 3 hours after the open house.

We encourage members to familiarize themselves with local requirements in advance to ensure full compliance and avoid potential issues.
